





# Let's go !!

#### 1—Eglise Notre Dame des Bans

Built in the 13th century, it is also called Notre Dame de la Basse Cour\*, not because it housed hens but because it was below the castle!



#### 2—Le Vieux Pont

In 1492 it was the main passage to go from north to south.

People had to pay a fee to cross the bridge (juste like on french motorways!)

Which river passes beneath the Old Bridge in Treignac?



#### 3- La Porte Chabirande

In the 13th century Treignac was a town surrounded by ramparts.
This gate was one of three entrances to Treignac. This one is the only one that still exists.

4— Cross la Place des Farges (the Blacksmith's square)

#### 5—Musée des Arts et Traditions

This beautiful Renaissance style home, behind its ogival doors (dome shaped), are concealed treasures of Corrèzian life.

#### 6- La Maison Lachaud

This house was once the house of the pilgrims of Saint Jacques de Compostela.





#### 7- La Halle

Built in the 13th century (just like the Church and the Old Bridge), it was where the merchants sold grain. It was one of the busiest places in the city.

What kind of tree was used to make the roof?



#### 8- Chapelle Notre-Dame de la Paix

This ancient 17th century chapel was used by the inhabitants of the walled city.

Today it is the Room of Honor of the Town Hall.

Look carefully at the tower.

#### 9—La Tour

Stair tower of the 16th century.

From the top you can admire the whole Treignac city.

How many steps do you have to climb to reach the top of the Tower?



#### 10- Le Collège Lakanal


This college, built in 1662, is currently the kindergarten and primary school.

The square was used as schoolyard.

This school bears the name of a famous painter of Treignac.

#### 11-La Rue de la Garde

This road connected the two missing doors of Treignac: la porte de la Pradelle and la porte Soulanche.

#### 12- Maison Fleyssac

This beautiful 15th century house was built near the ramparts and la porte de la Pradelle. It was used as a temple by the Protestants.
